You have probably been reading or hearing about the new budget that the President just proposed. You may also have heard about some of what it does. We have reviewed it and are writing to let you know that we strongly oppose it, because it would hurt the people that Community Action Programs Inter-City, Incorporated (CAPIC) is dedicated to serving – you, your family, your friends and neighbors.

It is important to understand that this is the start of a long budget process which involves several steps. We want you to know that the programs and the benefits that we help you access will not be impacted this year. The proposed budget would affect programs starting October 1, 2017. We promise to keep you informed on a regular basis as the budget process moves along.

We have expressed our concerns to our federal elected officials but now need you to do the same. In order to save these programs, we need your help, we need you to speak out. The best advice we can give you now is to call our Senators and our members of Congress and let them know how important these services, such as fuel assistance, are to you. They need to hear your story, about how losing these programs would make life incredibly hard and prevent you from achieving your goals.
